Readings for 5th Sunday in Ordinary Time (pp. 549-551): Today we hear about the profound conversion experiences of three great men of God: Isaiah (1st reading) is overwhelmed in the Temple by the Lord's holiness and majesty; St. Peter is likewise convicted of his own sinfulness on witnessing Jesus' power over nature (Luke's Gospel); while St. Paul, solemnly testifying to the cornerstone of the Gospel, Christ's Resurrection, recalls our Lord's mercy on the road to Damascus, changing him from a persecutor of the Church to a preacher of the Resurrection (2nd reading). In this Year of Mercy we, like Peter, are called to "put out into deep water" – deepening our trust in Jesus' mercy, come what may!
