Readings for the Ascension (pp. 500-503): Today we celebrate the Lord's final and glorious triumph over sin and death, the greatest "Mission Accomplished!" in the history of all creation! Taken up into heaven before the eyes of the apostles (first reading), Jesus now reigns eternally as our King and High Priest at the right hand of the Father (second reading and Gospel). Indeed, the Father "has put all things under his feet". What an unspeakable privilege to be joined to him, as members of his body, with the promise of following to where Christ, our head, has preceded us! St. Luke's account of the Ascension stresses our corresponding responsibility to share in spreading the Good News: "You are witnesses of these things!" Those words to the Apostles, who returned joyfully to Jerusalem to await the coming of the Holy Spirit, apply to us as well, each according to his/her own calling and state of life.

May, Month of Our Lady! The beautiful spring month of May is dedicated to Mary. Let's pray the Rosary every day for the needs of the Church and the world! On Mothers' Day in particular, let us remember that Mary, Mother of God and Mother of the Church, is our mother in the spiritual order.
