**Readings for the 17<sup>th</sup> Sunday** (pp. **604-606**): Today's Bible selections stress the power of persevering prayer, like that of Abraham (1<sup>st</sup> reading, Genesis). As well as exhorting us to pray always, our Lord also gives us a model prayer – the "Our Father". St. Luke's version, which we hear today, is shorter than better known form found in Matthew, but it includes the most essential points: the privilege of calling God our *Father* (springing from our Baptism, as St. Paul reminds us in the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading from Colossians), the duty of seeking God's honor and will before all else; confidently asking Him for our temporal and above all spiritual needs, the need for forgiveness, and protection from evil.
