**Readings for the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Advent (pp. 391-392):** As we now approach the wonder of Christmas, the Bible readings turn our hearts and minds toward two small Judean towns: Bethlehem, prophesied by Micah as the Messiah's birthplace (1<sup>st</sup> reading), and Ein Karim, where his expectant Mother would visit Elizabeth (Gospel). The 2<sup>nd</sup> reading (Hebrews) gives us a simple but profoundly theological answer to the question as to *why* God became man: "*I come to do your will, O God*". Only Jesus' perfect sacrifice of his human will in total obedience to the Father was able to bring us salvation.

**Christmas Masses: Friday, December 25**<sup>th</sup>, Christmas Day, is a holy day of obligation. Our Masses will be at the same time as on Sundays: 9:00 a.m. Latin/English *Novus Ordo* and 11:00 a.m. English/Hungarian. (We have no midnight Mass at SMV.) Next Sunday (**Feast of the Holy Family**) we will bring out our relic of St. Joseph's cloak. **New Year's Day:** Latin *Novus Ordo* Mass at 11:00 a.m.
